- Submissions will only be accepted in DVD format and must include two (2) preview screening DVDs. PCFF does not return screening DVDs.
- Final film selections will be made by the PCFF Board and jury members.
- PCFF will only consider films completed in the last three (3) years.
- Foreign language films should be subtitled or dubbed in English.
- PCFF 2011 will award "Best of Festival" in both Shorts and Feature categories.
- Submissions must include appropriate fees as listed below.
- Final selections will be made by December 15, 2010.
